Cookies On My Wix Site

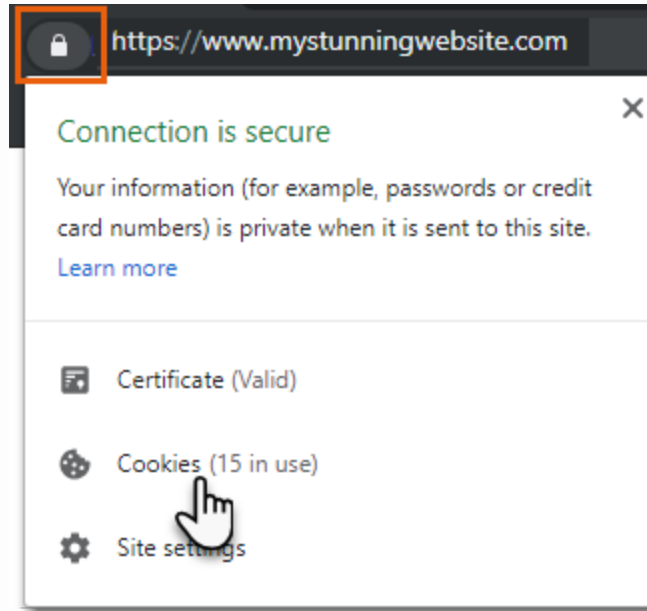
